
Installation procedure

- 1. Please read these notes carefully before commencing work. In case of doubt please consult a qualified electrician.
- Make sure the power is isolated from the circuit. The RESLOADE wires should be connected as shown:

2 uncoded wires:

Variable Live Neutral



Once the wiring has been completed and verified, switch on the supply and test the operation,

Troubleshooting

Lamp still flickers:

 Load not dimmable or more resistive load may need to be added, use standard resistive light bulbs to asses the extra load needed.

Precautions and Warranty

Please ensure the most recent edition of the appropriate local wiring regulations are observed and suitable protection is provided e.g. 6 amps over current, 1kV over voltage. Please ensure that this device is disconnected from the supply if an insulation test is made.

This product is covered by a warranty which extends to 5 years from the date of manufacture.

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Installation notes

Resistive Load

RESLOADE


DANLERS RESLOADE, resistive load, can be used to try to eliminate lamp instability and flicker when dimming non-resistive loads such as mains directly dimmable LED lamps, compact fluorescent lamps or dimmable transformers. The RESLOADE is designed for DANLERS Grid trailing edge dimmers (DQDGD) when dimming LED lamps although it may be suitable for use with other manufacturers dimmers when dimming LED lamps. Inappropriate use of the RESLOADE may invalidate the warranty.

For direct mains dimmable lamps the RESLOADE is connected at a suitable light fitting, in parallel across the load, between the dimmed variable live and neutral.

For mains dimmable transformers the RESLOADE is connected across the primary (variable mains input) side of the transformer.

The RESLOADE is designed to be placed into the ceiling void and can be passed through a 63mm diameter cutout, the typical size for down lighters, as shown below.

The RESLOADE has an effective load of 10W and an operating temperature of approximately 40°C above ambient. It should be installed where air flow is not restricted. It should not be covered by insulating materials or positioned near any heat sources or heat sensitive objects.
